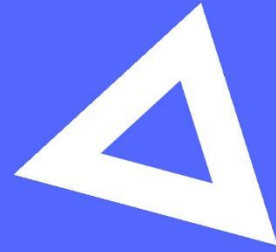

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1.1 Registering for the site

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e To sign up, go to the main page of the website, <https://education-in-russia.com/> and click Register.

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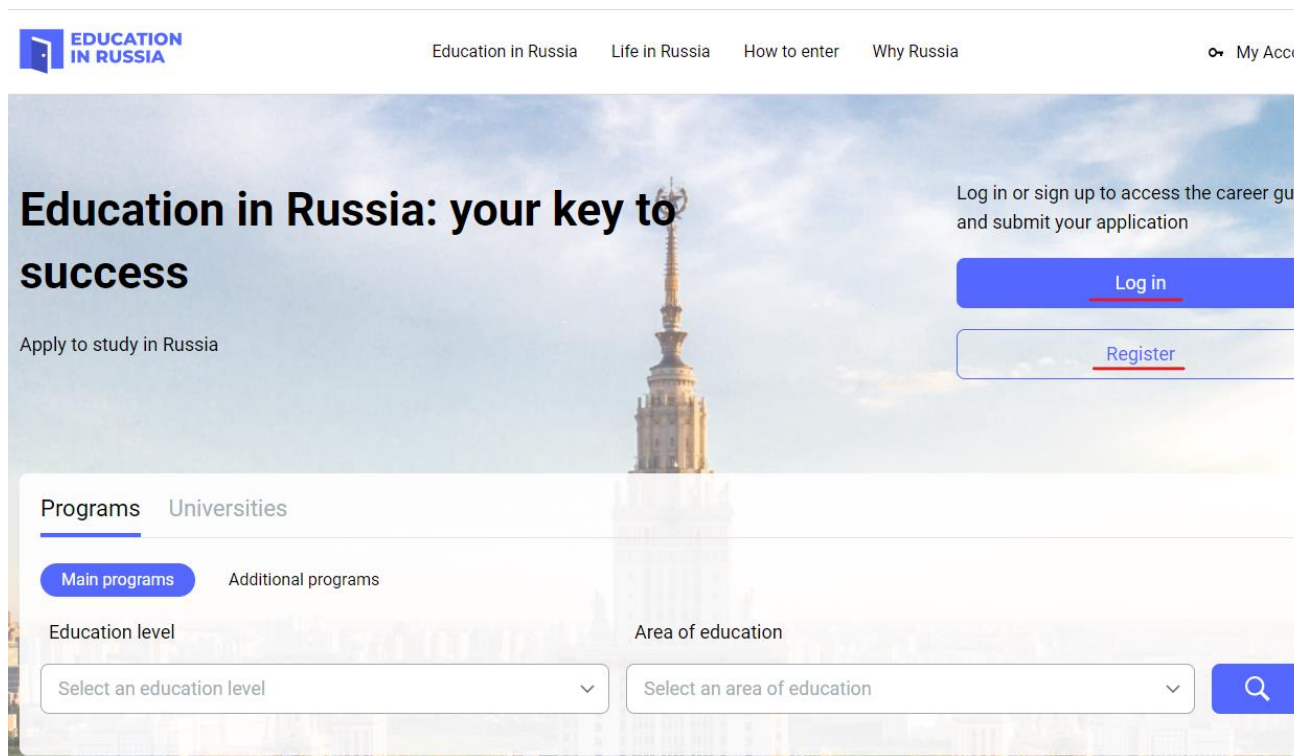


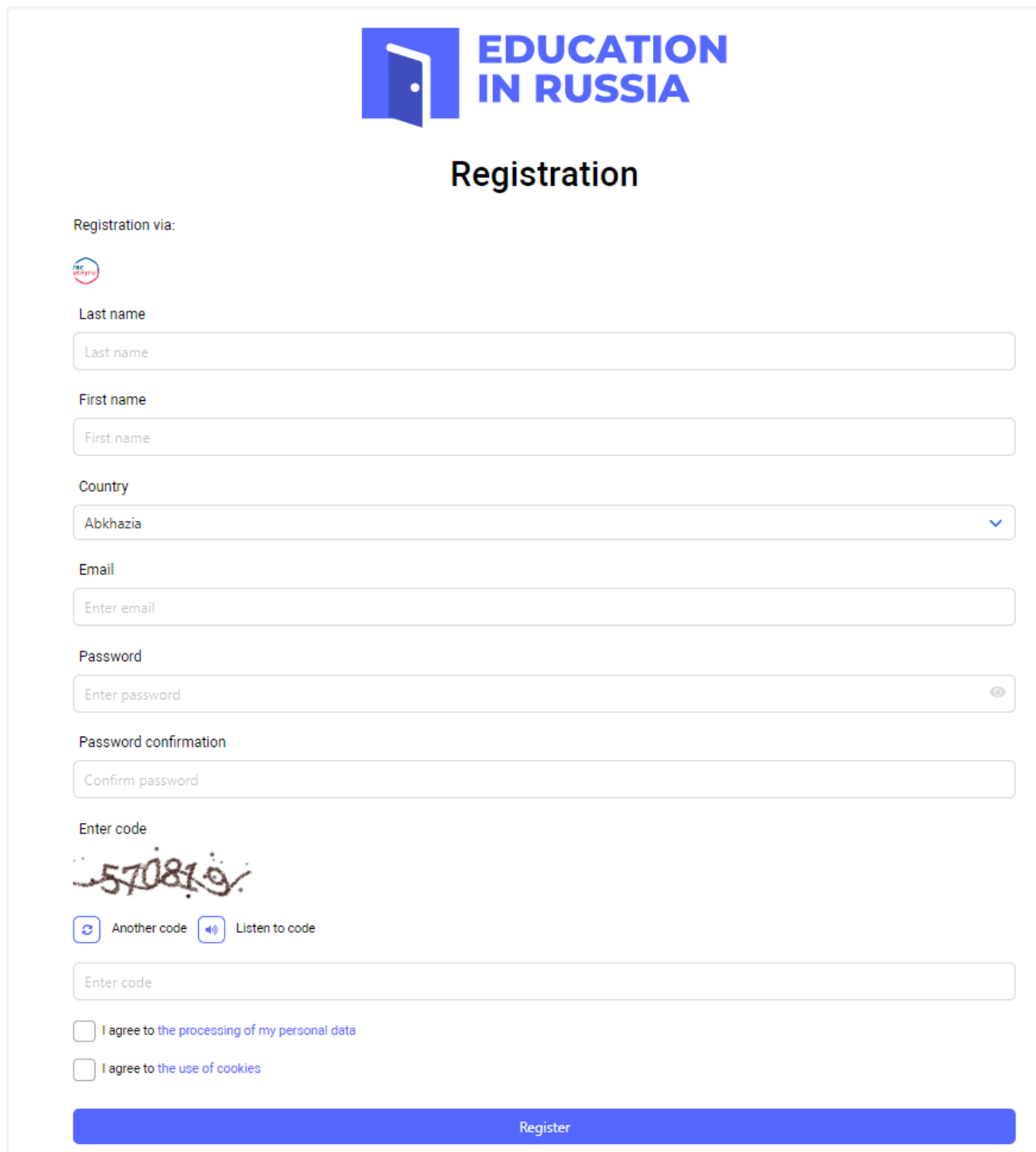
Figure1.1— Education in Russia website

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email. Click on the link in that letter.

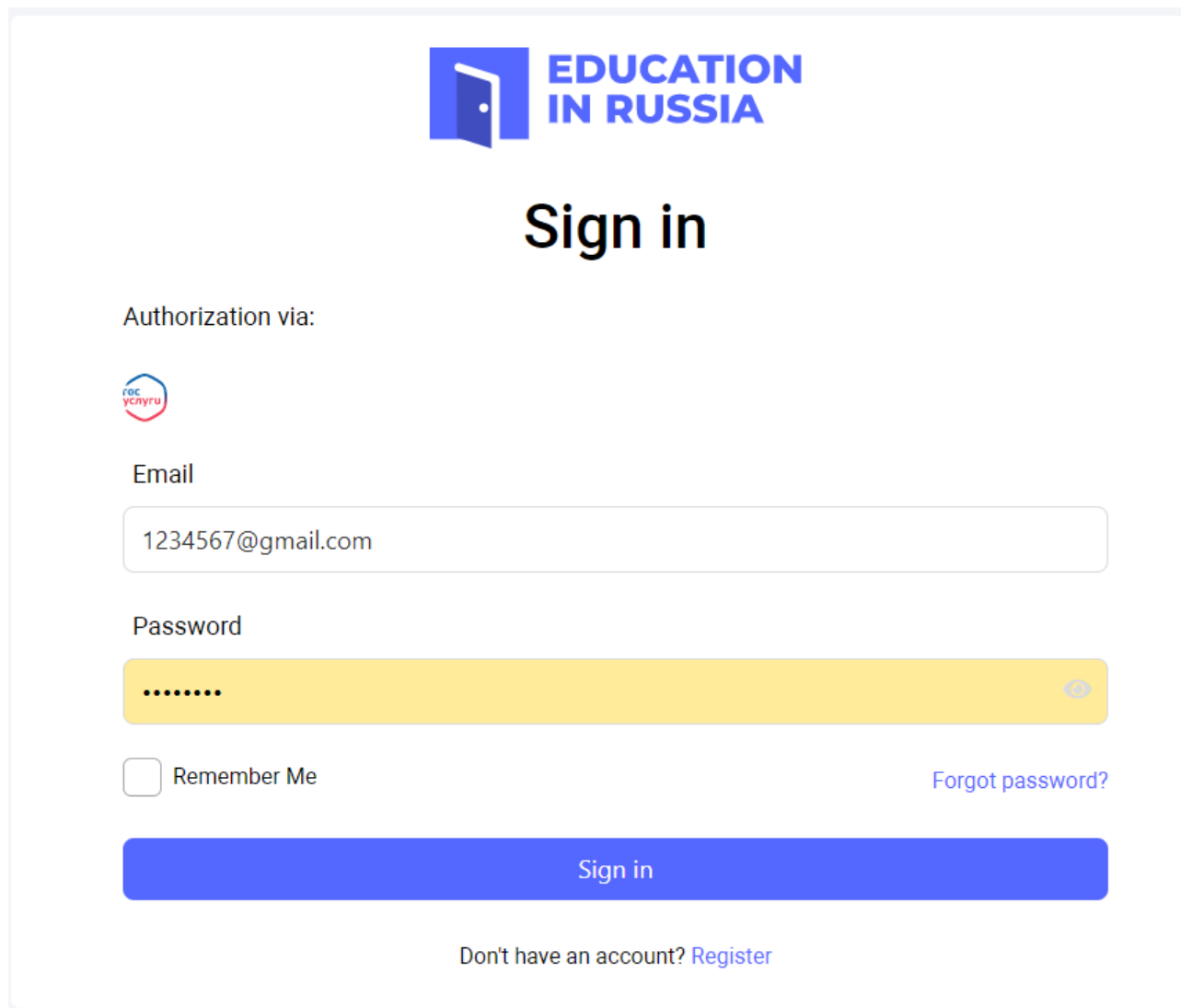
Figure 1.2 — Registering on the website

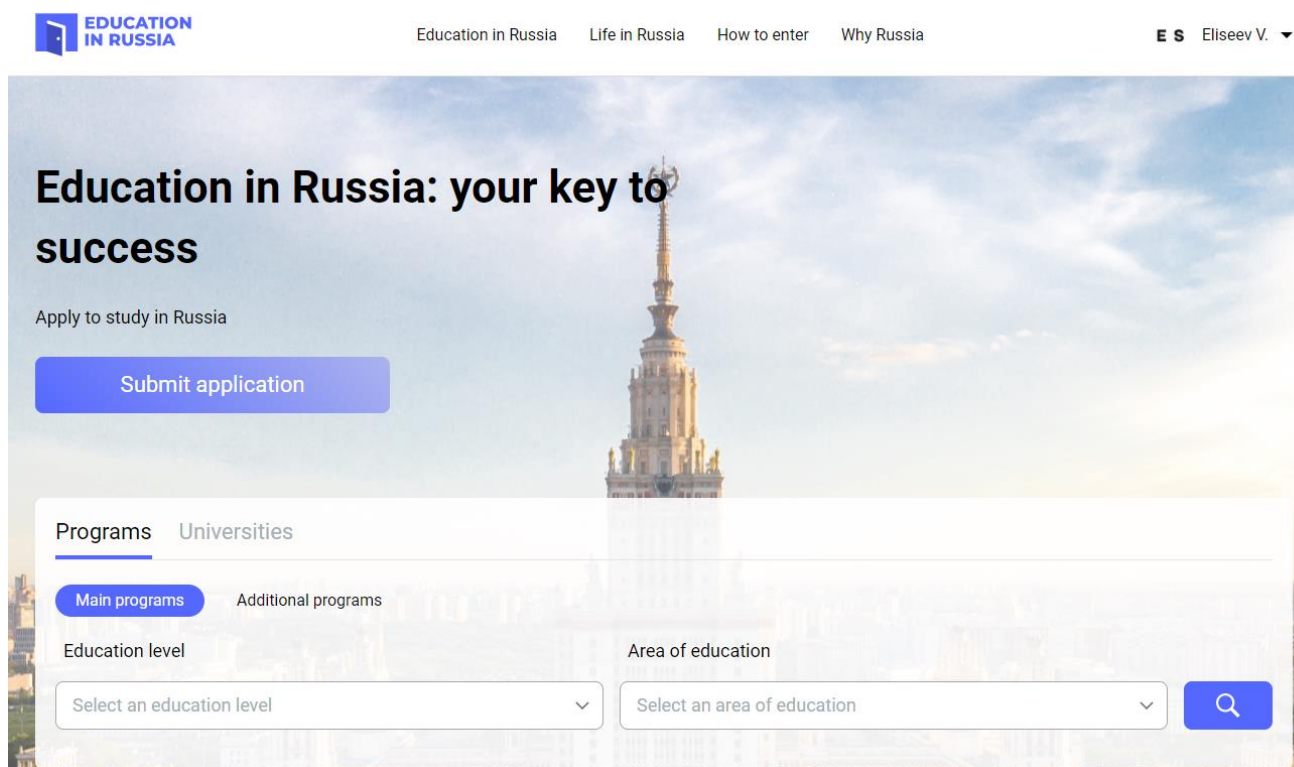


Figure 1.4 — EDUCATION IN RUSSIA after entering the personal account

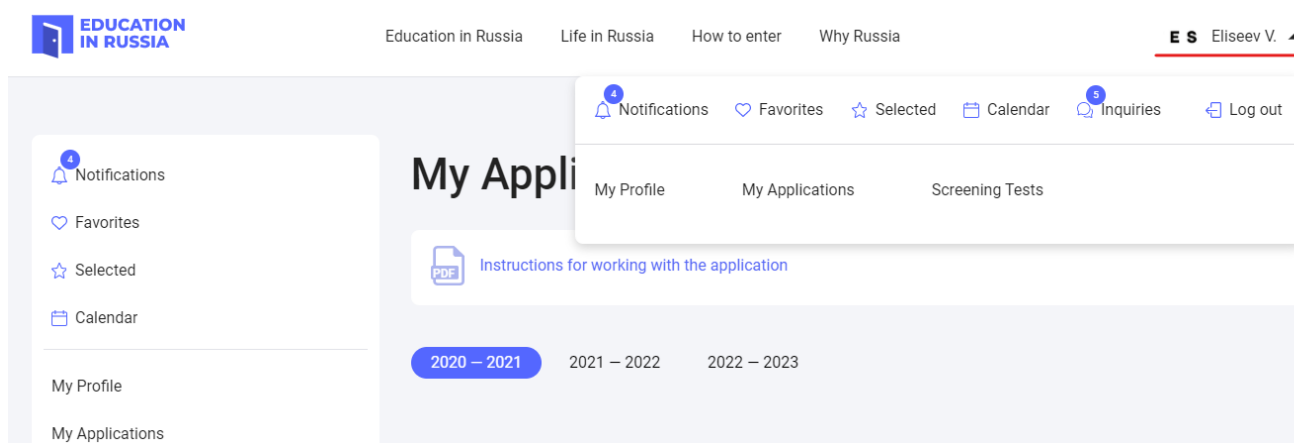


Figure 1.5 — Applicant main menu on EDUCATION IN RUSSIA

The following section describes the process for creating and submitting applications for those interested in studying at a Russian educational institution.

2.1 Viewing your applications

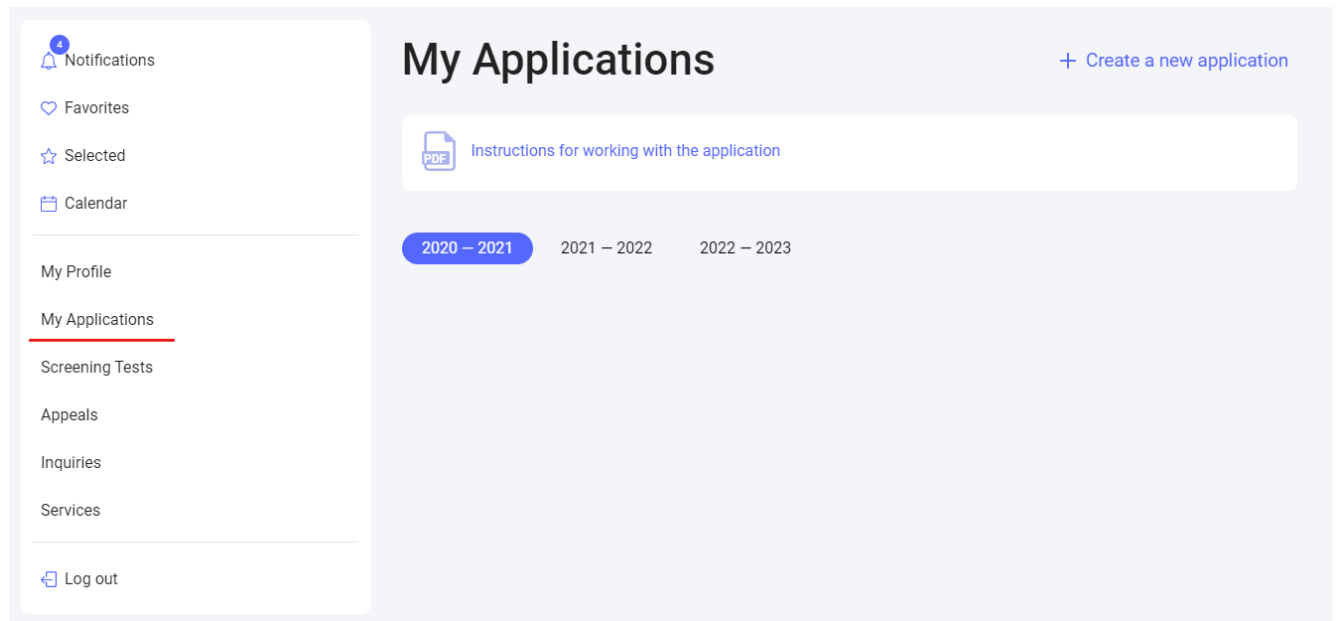


Figure 2.2 — The My Applications page

When you log in to the system you will be taken to the My Applications page (Figure 2.2).

Your created applications will be displayed on the My Applications page.

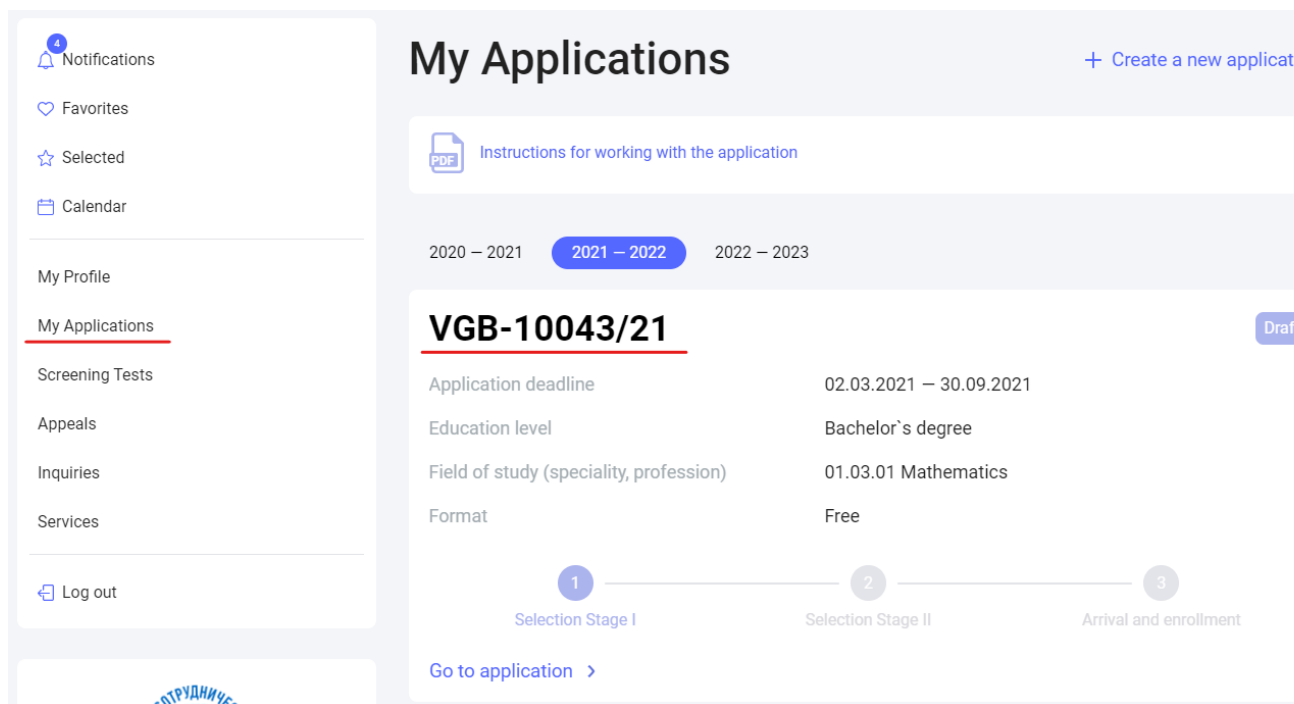


Figure 2.2 — The application displayed in the My Applications section

You can view your application by clicking on the Application ID (Figure 2.2).

You can also view your archived applications, but you will not be able to edit them (alter information, upload documents, or delete documents).

2.2 Creating an application

To apply for a Russian university:

1. enter your personal information;
2. complete an application and choose a preferred educational program and educational organizations;
3. print the completed application, sign it, scan it, and re-upload the signed application;
4. attach the required application documents and any additional documents;
5. submit the application for review.

You can create an application on the My Applications page <https://education-in-russia.com/settings/profile/applications>. To create an application, click "Create a new application" on the right side of page title (Figure 2.3).

If you have already created an application for tuition-free study, a notification will appear, saying that a similar application has already been created and you will only be allowed to submit one application for tuition-free study (Figure 2.3).

When you click "Create a new application", a new application is added to your My Applications screen. Each application has a unique Application ID. The application is marked as a Draft.

If you click "Withdraw application", you are choosing to remove yourself from the competitive selection process.

Clicking on the Application ID (Figure 2.2) will take you to the Form tab, where detailed information about your application is displayed (Figure 2.4).

2.3 Editing information in the Form section

The Edit button in the Form section can only be used for drafts and applications that have been "returned for revision".

To edit the form, open the Form tab in the application and click the Edit button (see Figure 2.4).

If you haven't entered any data in your profile, the form in the application will be empty. Pressing the Edit button will allow you to edit the form (Figure 2).

The Save button saves the applicant's information.

The Next button, saves your completed information and takes you to the next stage of the application in the Preferences and Achievements tab (see Figure 2.).

2.4 Completing the Preferences and Achievements section

The Edit button in the Form section can only be used for drafts and applications that have been "returned for revision". If the application has a different status, only the preferential order of universities can be changed.

When the applicants click "Edit", they will be able to edit their preferences (Figure 2.).

Select six universities according to your order of preference. The university in first place should be your first choice and the university in sixth place should be your last choice. This order will be taken into consideration when your application is being processed. You cannot choose more than two universities in Moscow, two universities in St. Petersburg, or three universities in a single federal district.

General procedure for completing the preferences section:

- select the learning format from the drop-down menu;
- select the education level from the drop-down menu.

If selecting postgraduate studies, assistant internship, or residency, you must also complete the Research Subject field.

If selecting Additional Vocational Training, the following fields will appear:

- semester — drop-down menu;
- duration of program.

General steps for all education levels:

- select the field of study;
- select 1 to 6 universities;

- indicate your foreign language proficiency. You must provide information on your Russian language proficiency;
- tick the box if you will need to apply for a preparatory course;
- provide information about any achievements in student competitions that might give you a competitive advantage (press +Add);
- attach a file confirming your achievement. This file will also appear on the Documents tab in the Other Documents section;
- provide information about your athletic achievements (press +Add);
- attach a file confirming your achievement. This file will also appear on the Documents tab in the Other Documents section;
- indicate whether or not you will accept a tuition-paying placement if you are not provided a tuition-free placement by quota.

After providing all of the necessary information, press "Next". Your data will be saved and you will proceed to the Documents tab. You can also press "Save" to save and view the information that you have provided.

The Documents tab allows you to attach or delete documents (see Figure 2).

Document requirements:

- files cannot be larger than 10 Mb;
- acceptable formats: .jpeg, .png, .pdf.

To attach a document, click on the corresponding field, then select the file on your computer.

If you have already submitted an application, you can attach documents from your previous application. This will only work for documents used in a previous application.

To delete a file, click on the X next to the file name. When you click on the X, you will be asked to confirm that you'd like to delete the file or cancel your action.

After uploading all of the necessary documents, press "Next". Your data will be saved and you will be redirected to the Submit for Review tab (Figure 2.).

2.6 Submitting an application for review

You will be able to print your application once:

- all required fields have been completed;
- all required documents have been uploaded;
- applications are open for your country.

When you proceed to the Submit for Review tab, the system will automatically verify that you have completed all of the required fields:

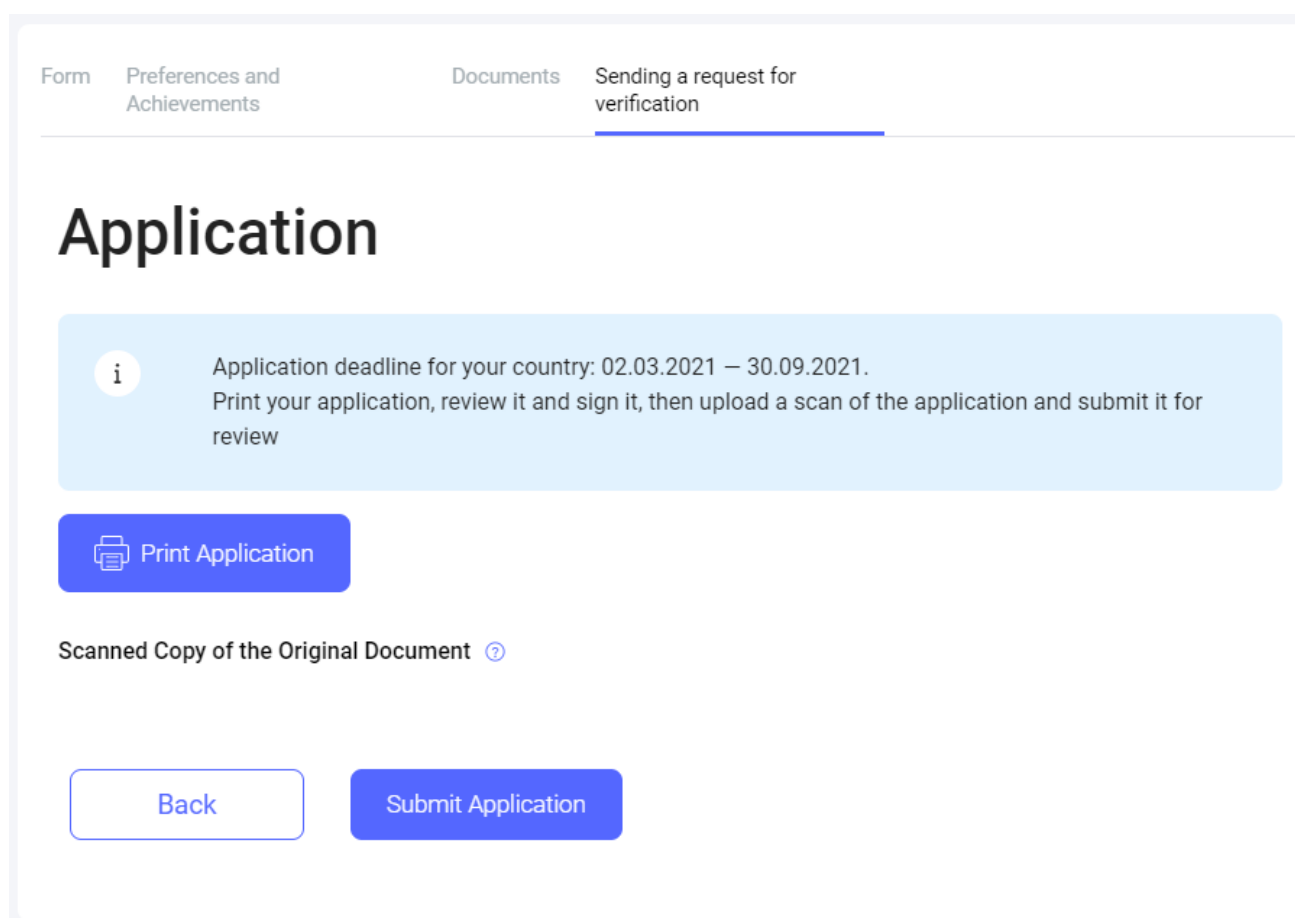


Figure 2.9 — The **Submit for Review** tab

You will be allowed to print your application once all of the required documents have been uploaded and the required fields have been completed.

You can download a PDF version of your application by clicking the Print Application button on the Submit for Review tab. The Print Application button will generate a completed application, which can then be printed or downloaded.

Click "Scanned Copy of the Original Document" to upload the signed document.

When you click "Submit Application", you will be asked to confirm your submission.

Once you confirm your submission, the application status will change to "Under review".

2.7 Withdrawing an application from competitive selection

On the My Applications section, you can withdraw an application by clicking "Withdraw Application" on any application that has not already been withdrawn.

When you click "Withdraw", you will be asked to confirm your action and will also receive information about the consequences of withdrawing an application.

If a foreign citizen still chooses to withdraw their application, their application status will be changed to "Withdrawn". The application will still be available on My Applications.

If a foreign citizen decides not to withdraw their application, the application status will not change.

If you withdraw your application, you will no longer be allowed to edit that application (documents can no longer be uploaded or deleted, the form and application cannot be changed).

3.2 "Visa Details"

3.2.1 Visa required

2. Log in to your personal account
3. Click on My Education in the left side menu You click through to your application data form The form shows your application number, application status, subject area of study, and education level
4. Click on application number

5.2 Viewing Application Details

Once the prospective foreign student has landed on My Education section page, they can view or edit their application details The top display shows their unique student ID number (awarded post-admission), education level, and subject area of study. The bottom display shows the sections Data Form, Student's Documents, University's Documents, Arrival and Stay, and Health.

The Data Form section shows key application details, which cannot be edited. Also displayed are: the candidate's photo, personal details, visa info, passport info, residence address, prior education info, candidate's contact details, and representatives' contact details. The Continue button is at the bottom of this section

5.3 How to Work with Student's Documents Section

To continue to the next section—Student's Documents—press Continue or click on the section title. This section shows the documents the prospective foreign student had attached to their study application. This section can be edited when the application status is Returned for Improvement.

To download documents:

1. The application status has to be Returned for Improvement
2. Press Edit
3. Select the doc you want
4. Click on Download File
5. In the modal window that opens, once again press Download File
6. Select file
7. Download Successful Press Save and Close

To delete documents:

1. The application status has to be Returned for Improvement

3. Press the delete button across from the document: the "x" symbol

The Arrival and Stay section displays the units Arrival Details, Your University Curator, Visa Directions and Invitations, Visa, Arrival/Departure Card, and Registration at Place of Stay.

5.6 Arrival and Stay Unit

Click on the unit title to go to the Arrival and Stay unit To add the arrival line:

1. Click on Add Arrival Details Complete the form that opens The required fields are Arrival Date, Arrival Time, Point of Arrival, Mode of Travel.
2. You can type in the Arrival Date manually or click on the calendar thumbnail and select date.
3. Type in your Arrival Time manually in the 24-hour time format
4. Type in the name of the Point of Arrival community manually.
5. Select your travel mode from the dropdown list. When you select Air or Rail as your travel mode, the field Journey Number will pop up. When you select Other, an extra field will pop up where to enter the travel mode by which you arrived.
6. Press Save

Once saved, your arrival details will be displayed. You can edit or delete this information. When you press Edit, the completed form will open in which the fields are editable. When you press Delete, a modal window will open asking you to confirm the intention to delete.

5.7 Your University Curator Unit

Your curator is appointed by a university officer. To view your curator's information, click on Your University Curator unit in the Arrival and Stay section.

5.8 Visa Directions Unit

You can view and download your visa directions. To view your visa directions information, click on the unit title in the Arrival and Stay section.

5.9 Visa Unit

To view visa information, click on the unit title in the Arrival and Stay section. You can add your visa or visa denied information and download the documents you need to apply for a visa.

To add your visa:

1. Click on Add Visa Complete the form that opens. The required fields are Visa ID, Visa Series and Number, Visa Type, Visa's Effective Dates, Number of Days of Stay, and Visa Copy.
2. Type in your Visa ID manually.
3. Type in your visa series and number manually.
4. Select Visa Type from the dropdown list.
5. Type in the Effective Date manually or click on the calendar thumbnail and select date.
6. Type in the Number of Days of Stay manually.
7. For the Visa Copy field, upload the file. Click on Select File and select the file you want.
8. Press Save

Once saved, your visa information will be displayed. You can edit or delete this information. When you press Edit, the completed form will open in which the fields are editable. When you press Delete, a modal window will open asking you to confirm the intention to delete.

4. You can type in your Duration of Stay in Russia manually or click on the calendar thumbnail and select dates.
5. Arrival/Departure Card Copy field Press Add File, then Select File, and select the file you want.
6. Press Save

Once saved, your Arrival/Departure Card will be displayed. You can edit or delete this information. When you press Edit, the completed form will open in which the fields are editable. When you press Delete, a modal window will open asking you to confirm the intention to delete.

5.11 Registration at Place of Stay Unit

To view your Registration at Place of Stay information, click on the unit title in the Arrival and Stay section. You can add your registration info now. To add registration info:

1. Click on Add Registration and complete the form that opens. The required fields are Duration of Stay at Registered Location, Place of Stay, Region of Russia, and Copy of Registration at Place of Stay. The optional fields are City, Street, House No., Apartment/Dormitory Room/Hotel Room No.
2. You can type in your Duration of Stay at Registered Location manually or click on the calendar thumbnail and select dates.
3. Select your Place of Stay from the dropdown list.
4. Select your Region of Russia from the dropdown list.
5. Select your City from the dropdown list
6. Select your Street from the dropdown list
7. Select your House No. from the dropdown list
8. Select your Apartment/Dormitory Room/Hotel Room No. from the dropdown list
9. Copy of Registration at Place of Stay field Click on Select File and add the appropriate file.
10. Press Save Once Save is pressed, a modal window will open to ask if you allow the act of tracking the location. When you press Allow, you give permission to track the location.
